Tickets for the luncheon are available in the choir room beginning today, after worship service. Reserve a seat or a table of 10. Payment required.

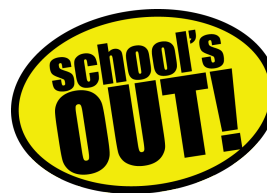
Journal advertisement/congratulatory messages are being accepted in the church office every day. The deadline: August 15th.
