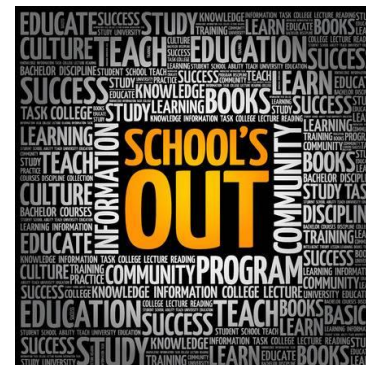
THE TOT PROGRAM OF OUR CHILDREN'S MINISTRY IS OPEN.
